

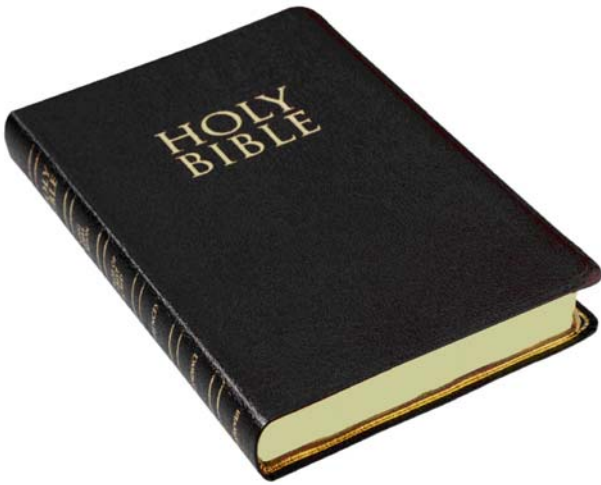

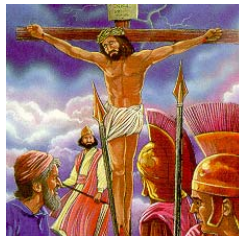
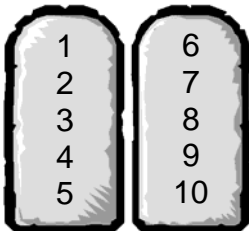

What does the Bible teach? God loved the people of the world so much that He sent Jesus, the King, to die for the sins of the whole world.

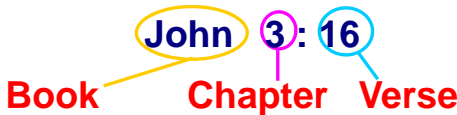
The Bible is split up into sections.

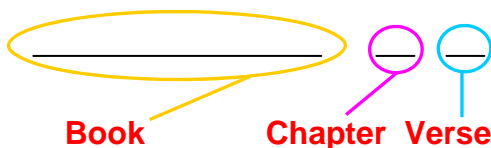

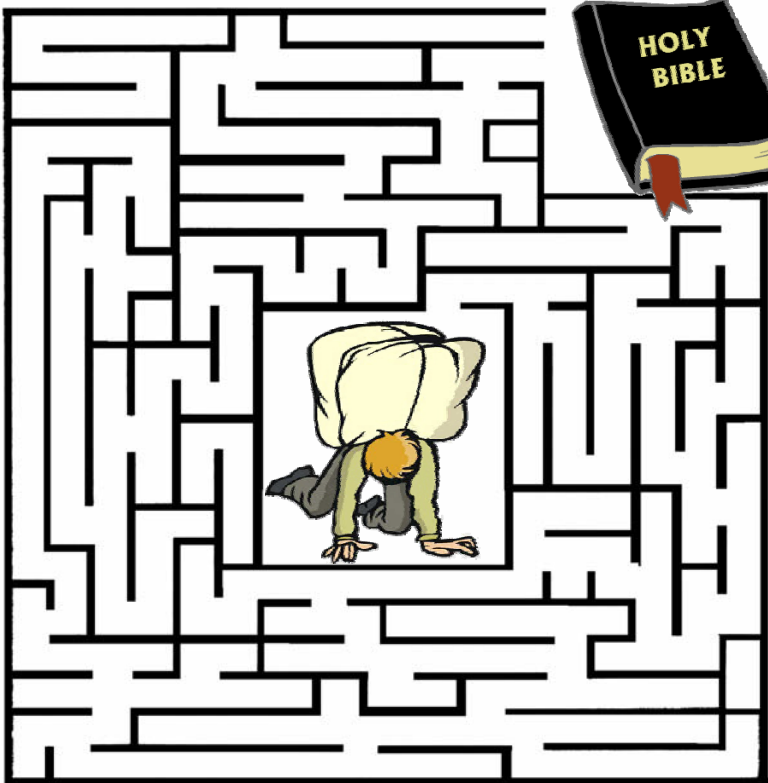

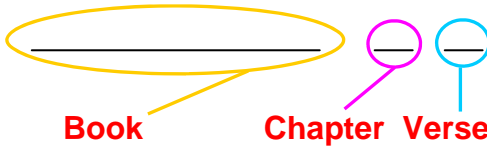
