What are the holy scriptures?

... the gospel of God, which He promised beforehand through His prophets in the holy Scriptures (NASB; Rom. 1:1b-2).

... the Scriptures of the prophets ... (NASB; Matt. 26:56).

... Paul, according to the wisdom given him, wrote to you, as also in all his letters, ... which the untaught and unstable distort, as they do also the rest of the Scriptures (NASB; II Pet. 3:15-16).

All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works (KJV; II Tim. 3:16-17).

The holy scriptures are the inerrant Word of God, the Old and New Testaments, the only rule of my faith and obedience, the only rule to direct me how I may glorify God and enjoy Him forever.
