

## In what sense are the three persons of the Godhead one?

... baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit (NASB; Matt. 28:19).

I and the Father are one (NASB; John 10:30).

But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit? . . . You have not lied to men but to God" (Acts 5:3a, 4b).

The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit, be with you all (NASB; II Cor. 13:14).

The three persons of the Godhead are one in that they are a single, eternal, indivisible Being, *the same in substance, equal in power and glory.*
