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## Love and Submission to Our Own Husbands by Brenda West

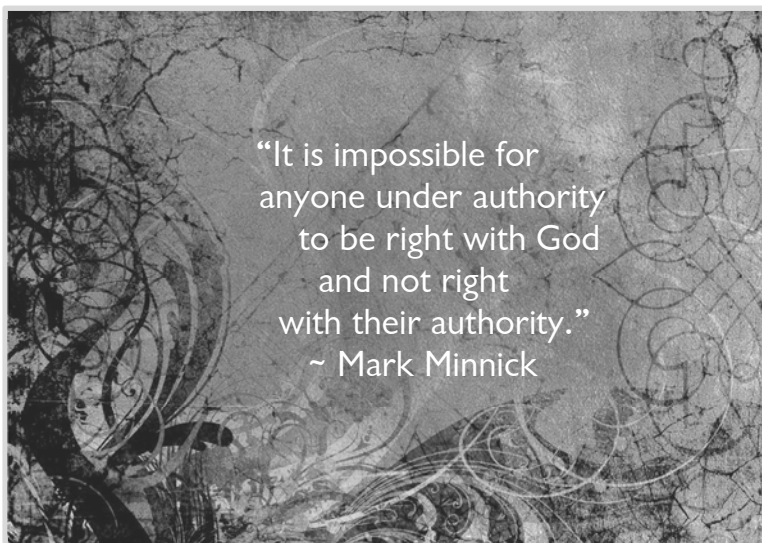
*Just as Sarah obeyed Abraham,

## **Commitment to Christ is Commitment to our Marriage.**

*I Peter 3:1-6, <sup>1</sup> In the same way, you wives, be submissive to your own husbands so that even if any of them are disobedient to the word, they may be won without a word by the behavior of their wives, <sup>2</sup> as they observe your chaste and respectful behavior. <sup>3</sup> Your adornment must not be merely external—braiding the hair, and wearing gold jewelry, or putting on dresses; <sup>4</sup> but let it be the hidden person of the heart, with the imperishable quality of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is precious in the sight of God. <sup>5</sup> For in this way in former times the holy women also, who hoped in God, used to adorn themselves, being submissive to their own husbands; <sup>6</sup> just as Sarah obeyed Abraham, calling him lord, and you have become her children if you do what is right without being frightened by any fear.*

1. Spheres of Submission are part of the Christian economy of order.
2. Submission is derived from a military term meaning to rank under or beneath. A wife “fits her husband like a glove.”



3. Why we find it hard to submit:
  - a. Humans naturally rebel against authority.
  - b. A wife has “extenuating circumstances” that she feels obviate her from submitting to her own husband.
    - \* Not about tolerating sin.
  - c. The wife is afraid.
  - d. Hurt and bitterness make submission difficult or impossible.

## **Submission as Taught by the Bible Makes Sense Only in Light of the Gospel— Living out the Gospel that Saved Us**

1. When we submit to our Husbands, we are actually submitting to the Lord.
2. The godly woman has her own personal relationship with the Lord that is grounding her faith and fulfilling her. She is staking her life and future on the fact that God keeps His Word and He does not change.

## **Respect is Paramount in Submission and Love.**

1. Summation of roles of husband and wife:  
Christ-like love for his wife; respect for the husband from the wife.
2. A “helpmeet” helps by adding a different dimension or perspective to the discussion.
3. Submission is trusting and allowing the Lord to work through your husband’s decisions, whatever the outcome.
