

## What is the benefit of our knowing about God's providence?

I will cry to God Most High, to God who accomplishes *all things* for me (NASB; Ps. 57:2).

Are not two sparrows sold for a cent? And yet not one of them will fall to the ground apart from your Father. But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. So do not fear; you are more valuable than many sparrows (NASB; Matt. 10:29-31).

In everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus (NASB; I Thess. 5:18).

The benefit of our knowing about God's providence is that it makes us patient in adversity and thankful in prosperity, so that we may place our firm trust in our Heavenly Father concerning everything that befalls us.
