What are the New Covenant's gracious provisions?

As applied to any believer (Jeremiah 31:31-34, as quoted by Hebrews 8:8-12).

As applied to the nation Israel (Jeremiah 31:31-34; Ezekiel 36:24-38).

In the same way *He took* the cup also after supper, saying, "This cup is <u>the new covenant</u> in My blood; do this, as often as you drink *it*, in remembrance of Me" (NASB; I Cor. 11:25).

The New Covenant's gracious provisions are (1) a heart that is new, (2) a knowledge of the LORD that is personal, (3) a forgiveness of sins that is final and forever, and (4) a restoration of the nation Israel to her promised land that is abundantly blessed.
