What is the chief end of man?

For from Him [as their origin] and through Him [as their effectual means] and to Him [as their ultimate end] are all things. To Him *be* the glory forever. Amen (NASB; Rom. 11:36).

Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, <u>do all to the glory of God</u> (KJV; I Cor. 10:31).

Whom have I in heaven *but You*? And besides You, I desire nothing on earth. My flesh and my heart fail, but God is the strength of my heart and <u>my portion forever</u> (NASB; Ps. 73:25-26).

The chief end of man is to glorify God and to enjoy Him forever. (Westminster Shorter Catechism, Q. 1)
