

## What is justification?

And enter not into judgment with thy servant: for in thy sight shall no man living be justified (KJV; Ps. 143:2).

But to the one who does not work, but believes in <u>Him who justifies the ungodly</u>, his faith is credited as righteousness (NASB; Rom. 4:5).

Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom also we have obtained our introduction by faith into this grace in which we stand . . . (NASB; Rom. 5:1-2a).

Justification is God's righteous declaration that we, though ungodly in ourselves, stand entirely righteous before Him.
