

In what else did Christ's humiliation consist?

About the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "ELI, LAMA SABACHTHAN!?" that is, "MY GOD, MY GOD, WHY HAVE YOU FORSAKEN ME?" (NASB: Matt. 27:46).

Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross (NASB; Phil. 2:8).

For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried (NASB; I Cor. 15:3-4a).

Christ's humiliation consisted also in His undergoing the wrath of God, and the cursed death of the cross; in being buried, and continuing under the power of death for a time.
