
⁷ But to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ’s gift.

The Woman Who Feels the Lord

-vs. 10—her worth

-vs. 11-24—her works (5 mentions of “hands”)

1 Timothy 2:9-10 Likewise, I want women to adorn themselves . . . by means of good works, as is proper for women making a claim to godliness.

-vs. 25-27—her character (as also illustrated in vs. 11-24)

STRONG ----- *Strength and*
DIGNIFIED----- *dignity are her clothing,*
CONFIDENT----- *and she smiles at the future.*
WISE ----- *She opens her mouth in wisdom,*
KIND----- *and the teaching of kindness is on her tongue.*
EFFICIENT--- *She looks well to the ways of her household,*
INDUSTRIOUS ---- *and does not eat the bread of idleness.*

-vs. 28-31—her praise
