## Mentoring Biblical Womanhood: Mothers of Teens

The MBW SS class is a four-year cycle of lessons held every year in the fall semester. This year's class is for mothers who have any children from the age of 11 to 18 years old. We encourage your participation, even if you attended previous cycles, to hear fresh perspectives on timeless truths from Scripture.

Based on the teaching of Titus 2:3-5, older women in our assembly will teach and encourage those of you who have pre-teen and teenage children to continue during these critical years "to love your husbands, to love your children, to be sensible, pure, workers at home, kind, submitted to your own husbands so that the Word of God will not be dishonored."

There is a \$5 fee to cover the cost of a notebook binder and weekly handouts for the class. Registration is recommended but not required in order to participate.
