The purpose of the *Way of Wisdom* Youth Bible Clubs is to teach young people in West Greenville that God has a way of wisdom that is very different from the way of wickedness offered by the world. The clubs aim to instill principles of Bible wisdom through regular memory requirements and character building activities.

Only teenagers are eligible for membership in the *Way of Wisdom* Youth Bible Clubs. Younger children may enlist in one of the area *Walking the Way of the Word* Neighborhood Bible clubs.

**Membership:** To become a member of the Way of Wisdom Youth Bible clubs, each teenager must fully complete the assignments in the membership booklet. Upon completing the membership booklet, you will receive a club membership card, a club T-shirt, and a new book of assignments. All Bible verses are taken from the New American Standard version of the Bible.
