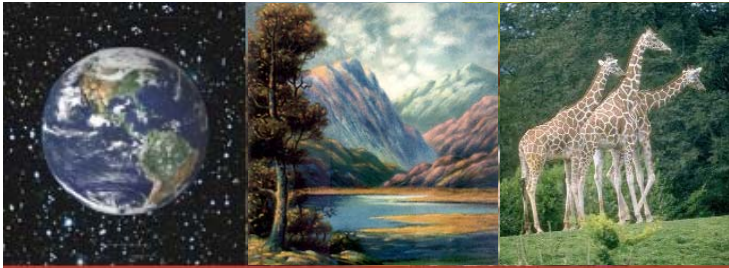

Then the LORD God formed man of dust from the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being.

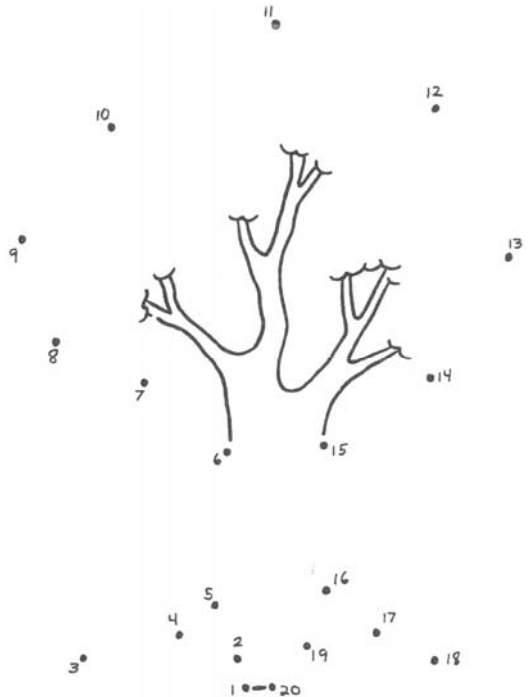

Then the LORD God took the man and put him [man] into the garden of Eden to cultivate it and keep it.

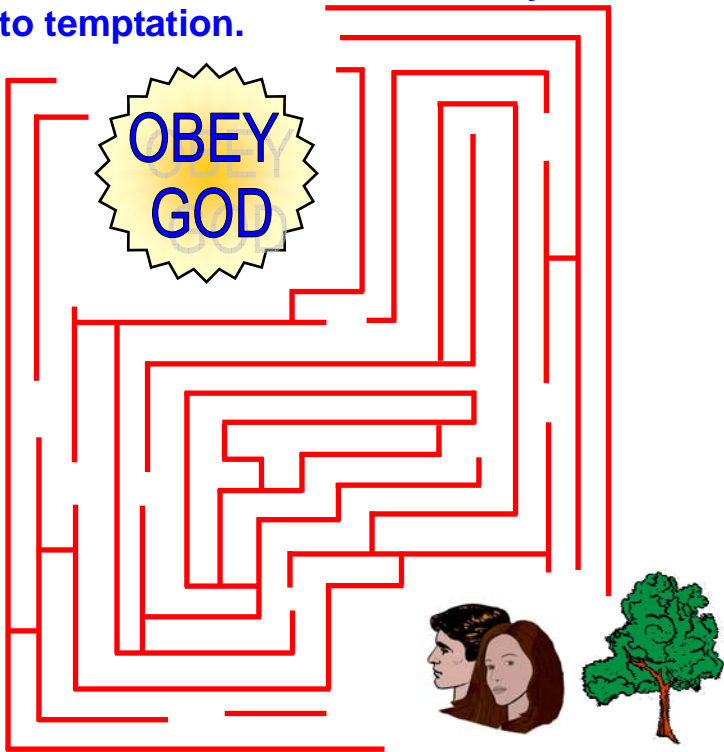

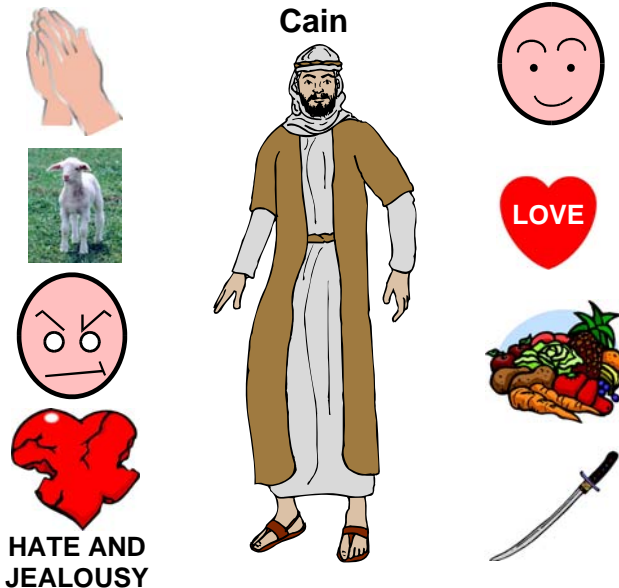

But [God] preserved Noah, . . . with seven others, when He brought a flood upon the world of the ungodly.

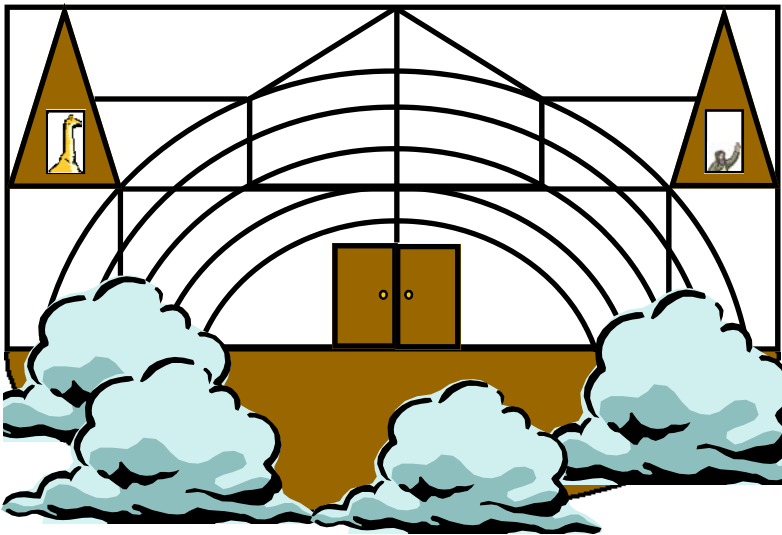
