

1. Where are you from? What brought you to Greenville?
2. How do you like living in the buckle of the Bible belt?
3. Where are you on your spiritual journey? Or tell me about your spiritual journey. Or what has your spiritual journey been like so far?
4. What is your religious background?
5. Tell me about your journey from Methodism to Catholicism.
6. You mentioned that you are Catholic/Lutheran/Methodist/LDS. How would you (or your religious leader) explain to someone how to get to heaven?
7. To someone who is flippant about heaven or hell. What if you're wrong?
8. What do you think God is like?
9. How would you describe your relationship with God?
10. The Bible says that God requires sinless perfection to be with Him in heaven. How are you doing on that score?

11. God requires a blood sacrifice as a payment for every sin. Who is going to pay for all of your sins?

12. The Bible presents two choices: each person pays their own penalty for sin or Jesus Christ pays for them all. What do you think about that?

13. *“Every person is made for eternity. Every person has a precious and immortal soul that must be forever either in heaven or hell.”* Matthew Henry
 - Do you believe this? Where will your soul live? How do you know?

14. Do you know for certain where you will go when you physically die?

15. Eternity is nearer than we realize. Are you ready?

16. Do you realize that the Bible says that YOU CAN KNOW you have eternal life?

17. What do you plan to do after [college, working, retirement, winning the lottery]? I know where I’ll be in 100 years. I know because God promises those who have received Jesus Christ as their Savior will have eternal life. I have received Him as my Lord and Savior, therefore I know for certain. How about you?

18. Are you interested in having a one-on-one Bible study with me? I won't ask you again. This is a standing invitation. (To a neighbor)

19. There is tremendous amount of uncertainty in the world today. How are you feeling about it? How are you dealing with it? (Then pray the Spirit would guide you to the next questions.)

20. What gives you peace in tough times? Can I share with you from where my peace comes?

21. Are you satisfied with your life right now? Are you searching for something more?

22. How did the birth of your child impact you? Then share your thoughts.

23. I am a Christian and I am going to pray & give thanks to God for this meal, is there anything I can pray about for you? (Leave a good tip w/a tract.)

24. I prayed to God this morning to bring someone across my path to share the gospel of Jesus Christ and He brought you. Have you ever been introduced to Jesus Christ?

25. To the stressed cashier: I'm so sorry you're having a bad day. Can I give you something to read that changed my life and my eternal destiny?

26. This dear lady who wrote this (tract-Ann Dykstra) is in heaven now and this is her story. Would you like to read it?
27. In all your years of [driving a cab/teaching school/treating patients] has anyone ever introduced you to Jesus Christ?
28. After a debilitating event, I ask, "I don't know if you have a relationship with Jesus Christ, but do you mind if I pray with you over this hard situation?" The gospel in one form or another is included in the subsequent prayer.
29. Who do you say Jesus Christ is? (Matt 16:15)
30. *For what does it profit a man to gain the whole world, and forfeit his soul? For what will a man give in exchange for his soul?* (Mark 8:36-37)
- How do these questions strike you?
31. *What good thing must I do to inherit eternal life?* (Matt 19:16)
- Have you ever pondered this question?

"Lord Jesus, You have my life, my job, my marriage... everything! Use me where You wish. I'm willing to serve You anywhere." That prayer was made by Jerry and Gina independently at different seasons of life while married to their late spouses.

Jerry became a Christian at age eight while listening to a Gospel radio broadcast. He was arrested by the message. He knew that he was a sinner and called upon Jesus Christ to save him from the penalty of his sins. Gina was saved at the age of thirty-six. Though she was introduced to God as a Roman Catholic, she was ignorant of the truth and of her condemned standing before God and that she could have eternal life by confessing Jesus Christ alone as her Savior. Through the witness of a co-worker, she was challenged to read the Bible. While reading a book about the end times, she was convicted of her vile sin before a holy God and called upon Jesus Christ alone to save her.

After thirty-eight years and eight years of marriage respectively for Jerry and Gina, the Lord took their spouses home to heaven. After Jerry's pastor suggested Gina as a possible spouse, Jerry took an interest in her in August 2014, and they were married fifteen weeks later! The Lord had not forgotten their independent prayers of surrender to Him. He has given them the privilege of serving Him at home and abroad in various

ways. Early in their marriage, they visited missionaries around the globe, helping with renovation projects, sharing their testimonies, helping at retreats, and teaching and preaching in church gatherings.

The Lord put it in the hearts of those at Gospel Fellowship Association to invite the Broeres to join the GFA family as Special Assignment Missionaries. Humbly accepting the immense privilege of that role, they have served in New Zealand and South Africa, and will soon be ministering in South Korea. The Broeres desire to share the good news that sinners can be saved from sin and reconciled to God through repentant faith in Jesus Christ.

What about you? Are you certain where you will spend eternity?







