

How does the Holy Spirit apply Christ's redemption to us?

See John 16:7-11: I Thess. 1:4-5

So faith *comes* from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ (NASB; Rom. 10:17).

A woman named Lydia, from the city of Thyatira, a seller of purple fabrics, a worshiper of God, was listening; and the Lord opened her heart to respond to the things spoken by Paul (NASB; Acts 16:14).

For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, so that no one may boast (NASB; Eph. 2:8-9).

The Holy Spirit applies Christ's redemption to us by working faith in us, and thereby uniting us to Christ in our effectual calling.
