Monday

I have a hunger to know God!

I am the bread of life; he who comes to Me will not hunger, and he who believes in Me will never thirst (John 6:35).

Does your heart feel empty sometimes? Are you hungry to know God better? God is telling you, "You need to be filled with spiritual things."

Wednesday

I feel pain whenever I sin.

When I kept silent about my sin, my body wasted away through my groaning all day long (Psalm 32:3).

When you know God, you learn that your sin hurts you and others. This proves that God's Holy Spirit is in you.

Thursday

I am quicker to say, "I'm sorry," these days!

For I confess my iniquity; I am full of anxiety because of my sin (Psalm 38:18).

Now when you say or do mean things, or have bad thoughts, you are quick to say, "I'm sorry!" And you mean it too!

Friday

I can't seem to change my selfish ways.

I can do all things through Him who strengthens me (Philippians 4:13).

No matter how hard you try, you can't stop sinning and often feel discouraged about it. This is a good sign that Jesus is at work! You have to depend on Jesus to change you.

What Has Jesus Asked Me to Do?

Monday

God has a mission for all of His disciples.

*Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation.
(Mark 16:15).*

True disciples of Jesus tell others the good news of Jesus Christ. You can share with your friends and family what Jesus did on the cross for our sins.

Tuesday

God wants me to learn as much as I can.

*Remember also your Creator in the days of your youth,
before the evil days come (Ecclesiastes 12:1).*

This verse explains that you need to learn all you can about God when you are young, before you grow old. How can you do that? A couple of ways are to memorize verses and listen carefully to Bible stories.

Wednesday

God wants me to obey His small commands.

*You were faithful with a few things, I will put you in charge of
many things; enter into the joy of your master (Matthew 25:21).*

God wants you to obey Him now in small things—like obeying your mom right away and cleaning your room.

Ask God to help you to do this job in a way that pleases Him.*

Thursday

God will help me find His will.

*I will instruct you and teach you in the way which you should
go; I will counsel you with My eye upon you (Psalm 32:8).*

God teaches us through His Word. You need to read the Bible regularly so you hear God's thoughts.

Friday

God will help me to do His will.

*His divine power has [given] to us everything [we need] for
life and godliness (2 Peter 1:3).*

What Do I See When I Look Closely at Jesus?

Monday

Jesus is God.

But these have been written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing you may have life in His name (John 20:31).

Those who believe in Jesus Christ and ask Him to forgive their sins will have a special kind of life . . . everlasting life.

Tuesday

Jesus was a Man without sin.

He is One who has been tempted in all things as we are, yet without sin (Hebrews 4:15).

Jesus was born just like us, except without sin. Jesus was tempted, but He never sinned His entire life! The next time you are tempted to sin, remember Jesus.

Wednesday

Jesus is the Only Savior.

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me" (John 14:6).

Jesus is the only Savior of the world, because He is the sinless Son of God who died for our sins and rose again.

Thursday

Jesus is the Only Mediator.

For there is one God, and one mediator also between God and men, the man Christ Jesus (1 Timothy 2:5).

Jesus is Always the Same.

Monday

By His Word, the Bible

*Your Word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path
(Psalm 119:105).*

The Bible is a light to guide us when we don't know what to do. God speaks to us through His Word.

Through my parents

*Hear, my son, your father's instruction and do not forsake

Through godly leaders

*Appreciate those who . . . have charge over you in the Lord
and give you instruction (1 Thessalonians 5:12).*

Thursday

God speaks clearly.

*I will instruct you and teach you in the way which you should
go (Psalm 32:8).*

God doesn't speak out loud, but He speaks clearly through His Word or through our parents and godly leaders.

Friday

God speaks lovingly.

*Can a woman forget her nursing child . . . ? Even these may
forget, but I will not forget you (Isaiah 49:15).*

Did you know that God cares about you even more than a mother cares for her own child? He will never forget you!

Will Jesus Do Miracles for Me?

Monday

Jesus will do what we ask in His Name.

Whatever you ask in My name, that will I do, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son (John 14:13).

Asking in Jesus' name means asking for the same things that Jesus would ask for you. But you need to get to know Him first!

Tuesday

God answers prayer.

In my trouble I cried to the LORD, and He answered me (Psalm 120:1).

God's answers are not always "yes," but may be "no" or even "wait a while." But no matter *how* He answers, we can be sure that He always hears and answers our prayer.

Think of one time that God answered your prayer. Ask God to help you to accept His answers when you pray.

Wednesday

God will take care of our needs.

And my God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus (Philippians 4:19).

Our needs are things we must have: clothes, food, and a place to live. God promises to take care of our needs, and often, because He loves us, takes care of our wants as well.

Has God ever given you what you needed? Thank God for taking care of you.

Thursday

God wants us to trust Him without miracles.

Jesus said [to doubting Thomas], Blessed are they who did not see, and yet believed (John 20:29).

Many people who saw Jesus do miracles never believed. Jesus wants us to trust Him without seeing miracles.

Friday

God wants us to give Him glory in everything.

Now unto God and our Father be the glory forever and ever (Philippians 4:20).

We can help other people know God is important when we talk about how great He is.

What Does it Mean to Forgive?

Monday

God never brings my sins up again.

For I will be merciful to their iniquities, and I will remember their sins no more (Hebrews 8:12).

God says that when He forgives us, He doesn't remember our sins anymore. There is never a time when God reminds Himself of all the bad things we have done.

Tuesday

God helps me through the results of my sins.

Return, O faithless sons, I will heal your faithlessness (Jeremiah 3:22).

God says that He will heal us, or help us if we come back to Him after we disobey Him.

Wednesday

I don't think about how others have hurt me.

[Love] does not take into account a wrong suffered (1 Corinthians 13:5).

Real love does not make and keep a list – either in your mind or on paper – of wrong things that people do to you.

Ask God to help you not to think about their sins anymore.*

Thursday

I don't tell others what happened.

Keep fervent in your love for one another, because love covers a multitude [a lot!] of sins (1 Peter 4:8).

Talking about others is gossip. When we forgive others the way God forgives us, we choose to love them and not tell others about their sin (**unless an authority needs to know**).

Friday

I am kind to those who hurt me.

Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you (Ephesians 4:32).

God wants us to be kind to everyone (even when they may not be kind to us) and to forgive others like He forgave us.

What Does God Want Me to Do?

Monday

To love Him with my whole being

Love . . . God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength (Mark 12:30).

God wants us to love Him first with all that is in us. That means our greatest loyalty should be to God. We show our loyalty by obeying Him.

Tuesday

To love other people

You shall love your neighbor as yourself (Matthew 12:31).

This is not a command to love yourself! It means that your love for others must come before your love for yourself.

Wednesday

To honor my parents

Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. Honor your father and mother (Ephesians 6:1-2).

God wants you to obey your parents, even when you do not agree with them.

Thursday

To read His Word daily

You shall meditate on it [the Bible] day and night, so that you may be careful to do . . . all that is written in it (Joshua 1:8).

God commands us to read His Word and to *meditate* on it. This means to think carefully about it and obey what it says.

See if you can memorize Joshua 1:8 and keep thinking about it! Ask God to help you think about His Word.

Friday

To pray when I am afraid or worried

Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God (Philippians 4:6).

God tells us in His Word *not* to worry, but to tell Him our requests instead, and then thank Him for what He has done.

Are There Hard Things God Tells Me to Believe?

Monday

That things on earth do not last forever

Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal (Matthew 6:19).

Things on earth do not last forever! God promises to reward us in heaven for things that we do for Him on earth.

Tuesday

That heaven is different and better than earth

[In Heaven God] will wipe away every tear from their eyes; and there will no longer be any death; there will no longer be any mourning, or crying, or pain (Revelation 21:4).

Have you ever gotten hurt? God promises to take all those hurts away for the people who love Him. Heaven will be a place with no pain, no bruises, and no mean words.

Wednesday

That money does not last forever

For wealth certainly makes itself wings like an eagle that flies toward the heavens (Proverbs 23:5).

God says not to trust in money to make us safe or happy. We should work hard to take care of the people we love, but we still need to trust God to take care of us.

Thursday

That God is going to keep His promises

The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you (2 Peter 3:9).

Have you ever waited for someone to do what they promised? God always does what He promises in His time.

Friday

That my heart is wicked

The heart is more deceitful than all else and is desperately sick; who can understand it? (Jeremiah 17:9)

Ours heart are tricky and can even lie to us. God knows all about us—we need to follow Him instead of our tricky hearts.

Do you have a tricky heart? Ask God to help you not to be fooled by your heart.



What Do Followers of Jesus Do?

Monday

They worship God in a special way on Sundays.

*Not forsaking our own **assembling** together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another (Hebrews 10:25).*

The first followers of Jesus went to church on Sundays. We do too, because we know this is what God likes.

Tuesday

They give back to God.

Each one must do just as he has purposed in his heart, not grudgingly . . . God loves a cheerful giver (2 Corinthians 9:7).

God loves it when His people happily give to Him. He knows that this is one way they can show their love for Him.

Wednesday

They obey Him by being baptized in water.

Make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit (Matthew 28:19).

After being saved, we are baptized to show others that we now have a new life as a Christian.

Thursday

They tell others about Jesus.

You shall be My witnesses . . . even to the remotest part of the earth (Acts 1:8).

Jesus wants everyone to hear about Him. Sometimes they don't listen, but our job is to keep telling the good news!

Friday

They read the Bible.

Like newborn babies, long for the pure milk of the Word, so that by it you may grow in respect to salvation (1 Peter 2:2).

God's Word says that we should want to read the Bible, just like a baby wants milk. We need the Bible to help us grow.

How Can I Be Holy?

Monday

By asking God for help

The LORD hears when I call to Him (Psalm 4:3).

God knows and hears everything because He is God. If we need help, we just need to tell Him. He may not answer right away, but He does hear and will answer us in His time.

Tuesday

By confessing my sins to God

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9).

God wants us to tell Him what we do wrong each day. When we confess our sins, God forgives us.

Think back through today and tell God you are sorry for the wrongs things you did or thought about.

Ask God to forgive you.

Wednesday

By obeying the Holy Spirit

Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God (Ephesians 4:30).

Have you ever disappointed someone? When we do things God hates, we disappoint God's Holy Spirit.

Thursday

By learning about Jesus

But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ (2 Peter 3:18).

The more we learn about Jesus, the more we know how to obey and please Him.

Friday

By reading the Bible

But his delight is in the law of the LORD, and in His law he meditates day and night (Psalm 1:2).
