There were a number of measures we took that the Lord blessed in giving us a perfect summer. One precaution was to reduce our camper capacity by half each week. Of course, half the campers mean half the revenue but about the same overhead costs. So the difference makes for an obvious place we could use your gift.

We are currently beginning our private retreat season. This season is easier to do under COVID since we are working with single churches each week. We will see if having a good private season makes up for our reduced summer numbers and keeps the bills paid. If that happens, we always like to see gifts go toward permanent improvements. There are two permanent improvements sitting before us: a swing gazebo addition on the lake and a much-needed remodeling of our staff house. We hope that one of these opportunities is what we get to use your gift on.


